



Guidelines for Elementary Group A



Part I Surprise Me (2 min for solo/ 5 min for group)

The Surprise Me Talent Show could be any form, such as storytelling, speech, singing, dubbing and drama, etc. Contestants could team up with others from the same age group up to 6 members (Each contestant needs to present English skills in the show).

The costumes and any props/materials involved in the performance should be prepared by the contestants.

The examiner may ask the contestant some questions before/after the talent show. Please answer the questions in full sentences in English. Here are some examples below. The samples are for reference only.

Weather

1	What's the weather like today?	It's sunny today.

Food and Drink

1	What do you eat for breakfast?	I like to eat eggs and sandwiches for breakfast.

3	Where do you buy some snacks?	I buy some snacks with my mom in the supermarket.

Part II Convince Me (Spelling)

The examiner will read a word based on the Quiz Bank. The contestants need to read and spell the word.

The examiner will ring the bell when the contestant can't spell the word within 15 seconds or spell the word incorrectly.

Contestants move on to listen and spell the next word until they finish 3 words.
